Today, Kajima Corporation and an Advisory Senior Manager of the Business Development Division of Kajima Corporation were charged for criminal offenses by the Japan Fair Trade Commission and prosecuted by the Tokyo District Public Prosecutors Office for a suspected violation of the Antimonopoly Act over Chuo Shinkansen Projects led by Central Japan Railway Company.

We deeply apologize to our shareholders, customers and all our stakeholders for causing such an incident in spite of implementing various measures for compliance over the years.

Kajima Corporation will closely investigate the content of the indictment and state its justifiable claims through the trial. As we take the prosecution gravely, its officers and employees will strive to restore trust through further devotion to thorough compliance.
